As you know, we are in the process of filing our new graduate program with the Faculty Senate for consideration and approval. The Graduate Studies Committee has determined that my HIST440/640 should be cross-listed with AFRA. Thus, as per protocol, I am writing to request that HIST 640 should be cross-listed with AFRA. It will get an AFRA number, probably AFRA 640. HIST students can take it for credit.

This course had, without notice, been deactivated by the Registrar (one of the HIST courses so deactivated). We have managed to get the Registrar to activate the course. Thus, it is now active and on the books. But we need to make a fresh application for cross-listing since technically the course is 'owned' by HIST. A statement from you affirming the above, will suffice and we can then proceed to include it as part of the dossier to be filed next week. Let me know if you have any questions.
